- underway for the General Assembly meeting in late June and early July. I plan to attend that
- meeting in person in Salt Lake City for the plenary meetings and to observe the Zoom committee
- meetings, especially the ones that our Delegate and commissioners are assigned to. They have

- item that will take up mine and Melissa's time this summer is the Synod review of our 2023

- of call for 2024 for installed ministers were due in March to the Stated Clerk.
- 26 Please get those in as soon as you can. Not everyone has submitted the terms of
- call. Thank you for your assistance. There are 22 such positions and only 5 have
- been received. This is a requirement from the Book of Order:
- 29 G-2.0804 Terms of Call
- 30 The terms of call shall always meet or exceed any minimum requirement of the presbytery in
- 31 effect when the call is made. The session shall review annually the minister's terms of call and
- 32 shall propose for congregational action (G-1.0501) such changes as the session deems
- 33 appropriate, provided that they meet the presbytery's minimum requirements.
- 34 The call shall include participation in the benefits plan of the Presbyterian Church
- 35 (U.S.A.), including both pension and medical coverage, or any successor plan approved by the
- 36 General Assembly.

- 37 The Terms of Call form approved by the COM for 2024 notes on the bottom the form is to be
- returned to the Stated Clerk no later than March 1st of each year. Even if there is no change it
- 39 should be submitted.
